PORT OF CALL: HUYS VAN ROOSEVELT



The former American presidents Theodore Roosevelt and Franklin Delano Roosevelt, as well Franklin's spouse, Eleanor Roosevelt, are all descendants of ancestors that stem from the village of Oud-Vossemeer in Zeeland. The fascinating history of these former world leaders attracts international and domestic visitors alike.

- *The Historic City of Middelburg*



Middelburg is the capital of Zeeland and has more than 1,100 monuments, such as the impressive city hall and abbey complex. The city centre with many shops, restaurants and cafes is still surrounded by ancient canals.

The Eastern Scheldt storm surge barrier is part of the Delta Works, created to protect the lower parts of the Netherlands from the sea. This 9km long barrier reveals all its secrets at the Delta Expo in Waterland Neeltje Jans.

In Oud-Vossemeer, the proud village of Roosevelt, an information centre has collected stories about the Roosevelt family history. The village organises tours, during which an international guide will take you on a journey back in time. A brief presentation about Roosevelt and Oud-Vossemeer in the Huys van Roosevelt restaurant kicks off the tour, followed by visits to the place where the ancestors of Theodore, Franklin Delano and Eleanor Roosevelt used to live, the Roosevelt Museum, the Four Freedoms monument and many more fascinating sights. The tour concludes with a special Roosevelt beer back at the Huys van Roosevelt, which can be combined with a lunch or dinner based on the Roosevelts' favourite dishes. The Information Centre also has unique Roosevelt souvenirs for sale. Whichever arrangement you decide on, one thing is for certain: This is an experience you will not want to miss out on when visiting Zeeland.
